# Real Results





- Working Groups fully eliminated
- Academic Senate (AS) sub-committees no longer attend OA

- NEW PROCESS!
  - "Self-study" is out
  - "Assurance Argument" (word limit!) is in
    - "Just the facts" specific demonstration of how we meet the criteria
    - About half the length of last self-study
    - Must be finalized by late fall 2017

# Triton's Accreditation History

- Full Accreditation granted in 1972
- Have not had a clean accreditation period since 1982
- Placed on probation twice (1990, 1992)
- 3 Focused Visits (1990, 1991, 1999)
- Have reported continuously on shared governance, assessment and/or planning since <u>1999</u>

# Triton's Accreditation History

If you want a different result, you must do things differently ...

As a campus community, we must approach our <u>assurance argument</u> differently and we must approach our <u>visit</u> differently

# Triton's Accreditation History



- Historically, we have:
  - Prepared self-studies that lacked genuine campus buy-in
  - Waited until the arrival of the HLC team to discuss our challenges
  - Asked HLC visitors to solve our problems for us
- This time, we want to:
  - Prepare a report that the college community supports
  - Discuss our challenges <u>now</u> and address them in the report
  - Come up with our own solutions
    - <u>We</u> are better suited to solve our problems.
