



## Degree Completion Agreement between Associate in Arts (with concentration in Education) degree at Triton College (TC) and Bachelors of Arts degree in Elementary Education or Secondary Education/K-12 Licensure at Dominican University (DU)

**Bachelors of Arts in Elementary Education:** Upon completion of the aforementioned A.A. degree at Triton College (TC), a maximum of sixty eight (68) semester hours of credit transfer from TC to Dominican University (DU). The sixty (60) hours required for the A.A. degree would be applied to the total hours required for the bachelor's degree in Elementary Education major a DU, and a minimum total of sixty-four (64) hours for DU bachelor's degree. A minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 is required for admission at DU, and a 2.75/4.0 is required for admissions into the School of Education.

**Secondary EducationK-12 Licensure:** Upon completion of aforementioned A.A. degree at TC, a maximum of sixty- eight (68) semester hours of credit would transfer from TC to DU. Students would then select one of the prescribed majors for Secondary Education/K-12 listed below, as well as the required Education courses. Participating students who already know which major they will choose at TC as part of their A.A degree. Major in one of the following areas: Secondary: Biology, Chemistry, English, History, or Mathematics. K-12: Art, French, Italian, or Spanish. A minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 is required for admission at DU, and a 2.75/4.0 is required for admissions into the School of Education.
