Completion of the AHL, Math, and Science prerequisites must not be more than 5 years old. All prerequisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. All test scores must be within the last two years.

General Education Requirements

Students awaiting admission to the program are strongly encouraged to complete all general education requirements prior to entering the program which are required for graduation.

Surgical Technology program courses taken at another institution cannot be transferred as credit toward program completion.

Surgical Technology courses must be taken in sequence and all program requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

Health and clinical requirements must be completed prior to registration for SRT205 (Clinical Experience I) and the requirements must be maintained through SRT215 (Clinical Experience II).

Students are not considered accepted into the program or eligible to register for surgical technology courses until they respond to their official program acceptance letter and attend the surgical technology program new student orientation session.
